**ANZMapS inaugural conference,
Mapping Climate: an Environment for Change, will be held at the
State Library of South Australia, Adelaide, 7-9 April 2010.**

The event is sponsored by the National & State Libraries Association (NSLA).

As the title suggests the conference theme is mapping and climate with papers addressing both contemporary and historical perspectives. The precise programme is currently being shaped but, building on the groundbreaking tradition of South Australia's Surveyor General George Goyder, sessions will address the mapping of climate change, vegetation, weather and fire forecasting, Murray-Darling mapping, and the mapping of river flow, rainfall and sea level changes.

A field-trip will include visits to the leading South Australian cultural institutions and cartographic collections.
