These lists have been compiled as a reference to assist in dating Australian (and New Zealand) maps by means of the government officers and other officials named on them. The lists are not necessary complete, and are not intended to be definitive, but rather comprise a working document which can be expanded as needed, and as research time and funds permit. Thus not only has it not been possible as yet to complete the lists of official in some positions, neither are all relevant positions yet included. Thus while there are included lists of Ministers of Lands, Mines and Railways for each state, Ministers of Water Supply / Irrigation, Electricity, Public Works and Forestry would also be useful to map librarians. However as such lists have not proved as necessary for the University of Melbourne Map Collection yet, and as they are already available in the various volumes by Hughes listed below, it has not been considered worthwhile to include them here. On the other hand, the lists of government printers and lithographers for each state, which were the lists first compiled, have proved more difficult to complete than expected, and further research is needed, for which I have not yet had the time.

It is hoped that users of these lists will add to them, helping to complete the lists already included, as well as adding new ones, so that a complete and comprehensive set of lists can eventually be made available to map librarians and other interested parties.

Much information has been collected from various internet sites, but for reasons of space not all such references are given. Where a source was used for one list, and provided most of the information given, it has been referenced at the top of that list. However a number of sources were used for several lists, and these are given below, rather than repeating them atop each list to which they contributed.

Charles II's instructions to Flamsteed were "to apply himself with the most exact care and diligence to the rectifying of the tables of the motions of the heavens, and the places of the fixed stars, so as to find out the so much desired longitude of places for the perfecting of the art of navigation."

Commonwealth Meteorologist (unofficial title: Director of Meteorology, from 1930s, made official 1955)

Conferences of government astronomers/meteorologists held in Sydney 1879; Melbourne 1881 and 1888. Central Bureau/Branch of Meteorology established by the Meteorology Act 1906, on 28 Aug 1906, operating from 1 Jan 1908. Originally part of Postmaster-General's Dept., became part of Home Affairs Dept. by late 1907.

Bureau of Meteorology transferred from Dept of Interior to Dept of Air Jul 1940, reorganised as RAAF

Directorate of Meteorological Services Apr 1941-Jul 1946; returned to civilian control c.1946.

Central Bureau/Branch of Meteorology became Commonwealth Bureau of Meteorology June 1955 by Meteorology Act 1955.

During the provincial era of 1852 - 1876, the office of Surveyor-General lapsed and the control of surveys was ceded to the provincial authorities. Following a recommendation in 1875 by Major H. S. Palmer, RE, that surveys should be supervised by the general government, a Surveyor-General was appointed in 1876 as head of the Department of the Surveyor-General. This department was soon renamed the Survey Department of New Zealand. At the same time, the Crown Land Department under the Secretary of Crown Lands was created. In 1892 both these departments were merged to form the Department of Lands and Survey, headed by the Secretary for Crown Lands. During this period there was always a Surveyor-General, who occasionally also held the senior land administrative position.
